White Wine

Sauvignon Blanc, Le Charm France £16.95

Overt bouquet with classical gooseberry pungency. Refreshing and quenching on the palate

Petit Chablis, Jean-Marc Brocard, Burgundy France £25.00

Clean brilliant and crunchy green apple bouquet with firm backbone of balanced fruit and acidity

Viura Blanco, Bodegas Principe de Viana, Navarra, Spain £16.00

Cold fermented in stainless steel to extract zingy flavours of lemon and grapefruit with a firm finish

Red Wine

Julia, Avondale, South Africa (organic) £25.00

Bordeaux blend of Cabernet sauvignon, Franc and Merlot. The wine is made by John Grieve in the beautiful Draken Vale. The name is Historical as it was Julia Grieve who fought for her African neighbours right to farm and live during apartheid. Deep ruby wine with open fruit of currant and plum

Champagnes

1. Ayala Brut Majeur NV 125ml Glass £6.00 £35.00

The Brut Majeur Non Vintage is made up of 40% Pinot Noir, 27% Chardonnay and 33% Pinot Meunier, blended by chef de cave Nicholas Kilm who has personally hand-crafted the wines of Ayala for the past 30 years. Owned by the House of Bollinger *Currently pouring in all the Gordon Ramsay's hotel and restaurants in the UK.*

2. Laurent- Perrier Brut Reserve, Tours-sur-Marne £47.50

Laurent- Perrier remains a totally independent family business producing a full bodied and highly attractive wine. Dried warm bread and deep scented fruit appear early on the nose giving way to firm elegance and a long finish

Rose Champagnes

4. Ayala Majeur Rose NV 125ml Glass £7.50 £40.00

Ayala, based in the brilliant village of Ay (hence the name), is a brand going through nothing short of a ballistic improvement in quality, thanks to the new owners Bollinger - also residents of this stellar village.

5. Bollinger Rose NV £60.00

This is the first time Bollinger have produced a Non Vintage Rose and it's a treat. Red cherries & raspberries mingle on the deep, inviting nose. The palate displays vibrancy & further red fruit notes but with a dark twist.

Prosecco

6. Prosecco Fabiano Italy £22.50

A light and fruity sparkling wine made from 100% Prosecco grapes in Friuli. With delicious notes of apple, pear and citrus fruits, it's excellent well-chilled on its own but equally scrumptious with appetisers or a fresh fruit salad.

Rose Selection

7. Old Station White Zinfandel USA 125ml Glass £3.20 £15.00

A delicate salmon - pink, medium wine that has been made using a very short maceration of the Zinfandel grapes after pressing. A perfect aperitif or as an accompaniment to light meats or fish dishes.

8. Ancora Chieretto Rosé Barbera, / Pinot Noir Italy £3.50 £16.00

Bright strawberry pink hue. Delicately aromatic with wild strawberry fruit characters. Light and crisp on the palate with ripe fruit balanced by tangy acidity.

9. Les Combelles Provence Rose France £20.00

The southern French coast has a reputation for being *the* rose capital of the world. These wines are not to be confused with the sweet white zinfandels of the USA. Combelles has very light appearance with peachy aromas and almost apricot palate.

10. Kintu Sauvignon Blanc Chile	£3.00	£15.00
This wine shows a bright yellow—green colour. The nose is elegant with dominant notes of flower exquisitely mixed with herbal tones. In mouth, the wine is crisp, fresh round and well balanced with a long finish.		
11. Mirabella 100 % Pinot Grigio Italy	£3.25	£16.00
Delicate on the palate with lightly honeyed fruit balanced by lemony acidity and a fresh, dry finish. The wine has gentle floral and citrus aromas.		
12. Ocean Point Chardonnay South Eastern Australia	£3.25	£16.00
This wine is a blend of cool climate regions specialising in Chardonnay production. The wine is fresh, fruity, with a soft easy-drinking finish.		
13. Orange Street Chenin Blanc South Africa		£16.00
Fresh, dry and crisp white wine. Youthful with balanced light acidity and soft melon and peach fruit flavours. Background flavours of citrus fruit.		
14. Serres Rioja Blanco Spain		£18.00
Crisp on the palate this is a light refreshing lemony white from the famous Rioja region of Spain. Perfect with salads this is the wine to choose if your looking for something lighter and not so alcoholic as some of the bigger new world whites available.		
15. M. Chapoutier Luberon, La Ciboise Blanc Rhone France	£3.95	£22.00
The Chapoutier family have been making wine in the Rhône Valley since 1808, but it was only after Michel Chapoutier came to the helm in 1990 that the wines really began to speak of their origin. This blend of Grenache Blanc, Ugni Blanc, Vermentino, and Roussanne is bursting with white blossom, lemons and exotic fruits.		
16. Octopus Cove Sauvignon Blanc Marlborough New Zealand		£25.00
Marlborough has one of the longest ripening periods in the world, this combined with long summer days and cold nights produce wines of great finesse.		
17. Domaine Langlois-Chateau Saumur Blanc Loire France		£25.00
Founded in 1912 and owned by Bollinger since the 1970s. Langlois-Chateau is dedicated to producing delicious wines all which are true representations of their terroir. A fresh, approachable and fruity Saumur which offers the freshness of its chalky soil with the white flowers and honeyed characteristics of its Chenin Blanc grape varietal.		
18. Louis Latour Ardeche Un Oaked Chardonnay France		£22.00
From Maison Louis Latour's operation in the Ardeche, in the south of France, where the ideal combination of limestone soil and a sunny climate provides perfect conditions for the Chardonnay grape to ripen and mature.		
19. Gavi Battastina DOCG Italy		£25.00
Intense bouquet, fresh fruity palate, with a complex finish, reminiscent of almonds.

20. Kintu Cabernet Sauvignon Chile	£3.00	£15.00
The wine has an intense violet colour dominated by mature red fruits, herbal and spicy aromas. In the mouth, it has a medium body, with rounded tannins, combining it lovely fruitiness with interesting notes of pepper chocolate.		
21. La Umbra Pinot Noir Romania	£3.25	£16.00
A medium dry, harmonious red wine that combines all the variety characteristics, exotic, well balanced and persistent. The wine displays fresh aromas of cherries and raspberries.		
22. Serres Tempranillo Rioja Spain	£3.50	£18.00
Maroon colour with a violet rim showing its youth. Aromas of fresh, red and black fruit, liquorice and floral notes. The taste is fresh and fruity, intense and moreish.		
23. Chianti Prunatella DOCG Italy		£18.00
Ruby red, with a typical Chianti nose, smooth, medium-bodied palate, with an attractive lingering finish		
24. Luberon La Ciboise Grenache / Syrah Rhone France		£22.00
Colour: A lovely ruby colour. Nose: Dominance of red stewed-fruit. Spicy aromas. Palate: We notice aromas of candied fruits. It is an elegant tannic wine.		
25. Domaine Langlois-Chateau Saumur Rouge Loire France		£22.50
Langlois-Chateau is dedicated to producing delicious wines which are true representations of their terroir. A leafy, fresh example of Cabernet Franc with vibrant raspberry sorbet fruit flavours and a pleasant herby undercurrent.		
26. Waterstone Bridge Shiraz Australia	£3.95	£22.00
The wine has a deep garnet colour with a nose of blueberry, cherry and spice. The palate has rich ripe blackcurrant flavours which lead to a smooth lingering finish.		
27. Terrazas de los Andes Malbec Reserva Selection Argentina		£27.50
In association with Chateau Cheval Blanc Bordeaux		
Aroma: Freshly crushed violet flowers envelop a deep core of jam preserves and ripened plums typical of Mendoza's Vistalba region. Palate: Racy notes of violet and graphite, are followed by mouthfuls of dry cherries and fresh berry fruit.		
28. Horse Mountain Pinotage Paarl South Africa		£30.00
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Tasting Notes Elegant and serious expression of this unique South African varietal. Remarkable subtle tannins with shimmering dark fruit and blackberry/mulberry bouquet. Twelve months in French & American (15%) oak.
